You can either go to your GP to have the tests carried out but please note that the results will go on your medical records and may affect any insurance policies.

COTS has made arrangements with a centralised laboratory in London for all of the tests. You will be given a kit at your Information meeting. You take it to your GP who will take the blood. This, together with the urine test is returned to the Doctors Laboratory. If you live in London you can go directly to the lab for tests.

Sperm tests must be done at a clinic under clinical conditions.
